Yes, you can unplug the battery from your inverter, but there are important precautions to consider before doing so. Unplugging the battery may be necessary for maintenance, replacement, ...

If I have to do something with a battery, I have to shut the batteries down, and turn off the breaker at the inverter. If I don't, I get sparks when attaching, detaching, and risk shorting something.

Battery connection must be first on my unit the sequence afterwards is not particularly important. Repeatedly unplugging the power cord while under load will damage the plug and receptacle.

Pro Tip: Always disconnect solar panels first if working with hybrid systems. Residual current can exceed 30V even when the inverter is switched off.

When reconnecting the inverter to the battery, first pre-charge the inverter capacitors. For the solar charger, make sure you first connect it to the battery and only then connect the PV array to ...

If you need to disconnect your batteries, you should disconnect your panels from your charge controller first (and tape the wires or wire nut them individually. Isolate and insulate.) I use a breaker between ...

To disconnect a normal inverter you simply need to switch it off. Then unhook the negative wire (black) from the battery followed by the positive wire (red) from the ...

The only reason to turn off an inverter or any other charging source, in my opinion, would be if it only provides a steady charge of over 13.2 volts, in ...
