Most homes are designed to support two layers, as sometimes people put on a second layer of shingles or put a metal roof over top of old shingles. So if the roof already has two layers we ...

The PV circuit is not installed on a building. The PV system is directly grounded. No more than two PV circuits are connected in parallel.

Therefore, with a single layer of shingles, most roofs can support the solar system without additional calculations. With two loads of shingles, probably much more complicated.
