Spain is constructing the country's largest urban solar farm by installing about 7,000 solar panels over cemeteries in the city of Valencia as part ...

Around 7,000 photovoltaic panels have been placed on crypts and other structures in public cemeteries in Valencia, according to a European Union ...

In the town of Saint-Joachim, in Loire-Atlantique, a unique project in France plans to cover the town's cemetery with 9 m<sup>2</sup> of photovoltaic panels in the form of shade structures.

Launched in May 2024, the project involves installing solar panels in multiple cemeteries across Valencia.

The townsfolk began installing solar panels in the cemetery some time ago and plan to have 1.3 MW of solar output by 2025. This will help supply ...
